I was born on a small farm near the Deep Run area of Bedminster Twp, Bucks Co PA, not far from what is believed to be the original Overholt homestead. I was born and raised as a Mennonite and attended a Mennonite college in Goshen IN. My wife, Jean Myers also has deep roots in Bedminster and Plumstead Twp. Since we have 4 daughters (and 10 grandchildren), we have done little to carry on the Overholt name. After being in the Real Estate business for 29 years in Doylestown PA, we retired and now spend our winters near Fort Myers FL.

In 1986, 4 generations - my mother who was then 76, my wife and I, our 4 daughters with husbands and grandchildren, toured Switzerland via train and the Glacier Express. At the end of the two weeks, we attended the Oberholzer Reunion in the small village of Oberholz in the Alps, east of Zurich. My mother, who speaks Pennsylvania Dutch fluently, had no trouble conversing with Rosy Oberholzer who organized the 2 day Reunion attended by 35 Americans and 85 Swiss. The following summer, my wife and I rented a small cottage in the Alps near the village of Oberholz. During the entire month of June, I hiked and drove 2000 miles exploring the land of my forefathers. I guess one might say, I am an authentic Overholt.

I am pleased to be your president for the next two years.

Our publisher is the Olde Springfield Shoppe in Elverson Pa and I found that the format I had on my disks would not fit into their computer program, so to save the additional expense, I redid the whole manuscript. I am now back to riding my stationary bike 3 miles a day and am looking forward to working in my garden come spring. I have always enjoyed a challenge and this is one I won't soon forget.

Rev John Weiler gave the Benediction.


