"The letters from Germany to the Commission of Foreign Needs in the Netherlands. These letters were written in 1731 for Hans Heinrich Martin and his wife Anna Oberholzer. The letters note that Hans Heinrich Martin had farmed in the Kraichgau region of Baden from 1728-1730 and as 'a result the great misfortune of a fire on my farm' his total harvest was lost. The letter states that Hans and Anna behaved as good servants, and cared for the land and goods as an experienced and able farmer. The letter continues that this family sought to go to Pennsylvania 'to seek their fortune by God's help'. This family settled in Lancaster County and is designated later in this book as (AO)." - Part of introduction written by Willard E Overholtzer, Rancho Cordova CA, in *The Oberholtzer Book*, 1995 Barbara B Ford

Hans Martin & Anna immigrated 9/21/1731 on Britannia with 4 children from near Heidelberg GER and are said to have first stayed on the purchased but unsettled (JL) Oberholtzer farm near Bowmansville until they purchased their own land on the Conestoga Creek in 1733.

## BO Elizabeth Buzzard Oberholtzer

Another family was immigrating from Germany in 1740. The father and a son, names unknown, died aboard ship in the Atlantic Ocean. His wife, Elizabeth Buzzard, sold herself as an indentured slave for 3 years near Moorhead in present day West Virginia. She was freed in 1 1/5 years, and married William Stingly of the Church of the Brethren.
